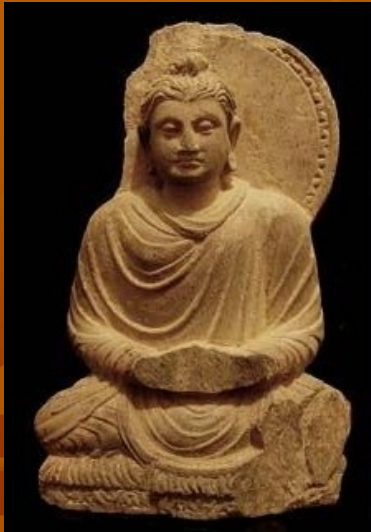


DIFFERENT TRADITIONS – ONE WISDOM
