TRADITIONAL

BUDDHIST CEREMONY

VENUE | FRONT SHRINE

A traditional Buddhist Ceremony conducted by the Reverends in the Great Compassion Shrine (Front Shrine). The ceremony is a gift from the temple and the duration is approximately 30 – 45 minutes.

The couple has use of the Shrine for up to ONE HOUR, This includes the ceremony, setup/cleanup and photography.

The fee includes:

- Venue hire only with wedding table and seating for up to 80 guests
- All other decorations, flowers, seat covers etc. to be supplied by couple. This must be set up and cleared away by wedding party within the one hour time frame.
- around 15 minutes of photography in the Front Shrine at completion of ceremony.

OPTION 1

Venue hire only

- Enjoy a secular wedding service by bringing your own celebrant.
- Please note: No other religious/non-religious rituals are to be performed during the ceremony, in Shrines or garden. Please refer to our Terms and Conditions for further information.

OPTION 2

Venue hire and ceremony officiated by temple Venerable

- This option is perfect for those wishing to have a less formal service than the Traditional Buddhist Ceremony which is held at the Front Shrine.
- Your union will be blessed by the Buddha
- We will handle all the legal paperwork for you so you don't have to worry about a thing.

The rate includes the use of the grounds for the Ceremony and photography for up to three hours.

BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please read carefully through these Terms and Conditions before signing below.

1. Bookings and Deposit

Bookings must be made at least four weeks in advance; this includes completing and returning the attached application form(s) along with a 20% non-refundable deposit (form only for just photography). The application form must be signed by a person aged 18 years or over and remain in attendance throughout the specified hiring period.

2. Fees/Payment

Following the deposit the balance must be paid no later than two weeks prior to the booked date.

3. Hours of Use

Hiring times include time required for setting up and packing away after the event.

4. Bridal Cars and Guest Parking.

Guest vehicles MUST enter via our main entrance, 180 Berkeley Road, Berkeley and park in the main car-park.

Wedding cars may arrive via our Nolan Street entrance and park around the Lotus Pond.

5. Morning or Afternoon Tea

Catering arrangements can be made with the Nan Tien Temple if you wish to have morning / afternoon tea for your guests.

6. Cancellation of Booking

All cancellations must be submitted in writing 2 weeks prior to the specified date. Please note that the deposit made for the booking is non refundable.

7. Code of Conduct and Behaviour

As Nan Tien Temple is a religious venue, any alcohol, meat, seafood, illegal drugs and smoking is strictly prohibited in the Temple grounds. No pets, cats or dogs are allowed in Temple grounds.

8. Lost/Damage/Theft

Nan Tien Temple regrets that we cannot accept responsibility for any lost or stolen items.

9. Rituals

No other religious/non-religious rituals are to be performed during the ceremony in Shrines or Garden.
