



2022 Earth Day ~ "SDG 13 Climate Action" Three Acts of Goodness Writing Activity

1. Background: The United Nations calls on the world to work together to combat climate change aiming for zero carbon emission by 2050. Limiting global warming to 1.5°C will benefit people and natural ecosystems. Reducing carbon footprint in daily life can reverse the impacts of climate change.

2. Objectives: “1.5°C New Lifestyle” – walk more, consume less meat, use green energy, and reduce carbon footprint in daily life. This activity aims to encourage children to express the theme 'reduce carbon and save the Earth' in their own words, and to inspire people to do the right thing and change their lifestyle. It is our shared responsibility to protect the Earth and to work together to mitigate climate change.

- Please complete the application form clearly and in full. Entries with incomplete information and illegible writing will not be accepted.
- The writing has to be original composition created by the participant. Any submitted work found to be copied or plagiarised will be disqualified.
- All entries will not be returned. The ownership and copyright belong to the Organiser “Nan Tian Chinese School of Sydney”.
- The Organiser holds the right to amend any rules and regulations as and when necessary and publish it on the Facebook page of FGS Nan Tien Buddhist Temple Parramatta / Nan Tian Chinese School of Sydney.
