Please read carefully through the Terms and Conditions before signing below. Please inform <u>all participants</u> of Nan Tien Temple's rules and regulations (Including payment clerks).

- A \$50 deposit, or \$100 deposit for groups larger than 50 people, is required to secure your booking and is to be received by the due date stated on the invoice. Failure to pay the deposit by the due date will result in a cancellation of your tentative booking.
- The final balance <u>must</u> be paid 3 days prior to the date of the tour. Failure to make final payment could result in cancellation of the tour.
- Deposits are non-refundable.
- Cancellations made less than 3 days prior to the tour: **full amount is non refundable**.
- Where group numbers fall below 15, tour & activities will still be charged for a minimum of 15; lunch will be charged per head.
- If the number of participants in the group reduces from the number booked within 3 days prior to the tour, there will be **NO REIMBURSEMENTS**.
- All refunds will be paid by cheque only.
- If you encounter difficulties in arriving at the appointed time, please telephone Nan Tien Temple as soon as possible, for alternative arrangements to be made.
- Nan Tien Temple regrets that we cannot accept responsibility for lost or stolen items.
- NO food, alcohol, cigarettes, beverages, etc are permitted on Temple grounds. Masks must be worn indoors (for ages 12+)
- Please wear appropriate clothing on the day of your tour, i.e. no short shorts, shoe-string straps or thongs.
