Introduction

The NSW Department of Education requires all staff in NSW public schools and its other education settings to participate in an initial child protection induction.

The Department is pleased to present an externally accessible version of *Child Protection Awareness Training*, a self-paced e-learning course that provides this initial child protection induction training. This version is identical to the internal version, however the internal version can only be accessed by the NSW Department of Education employees using their departmental log-in.

Staff employed by the Department who have a portal login username and password should complete the internal version (under 'Courses > Compliance training' on the department's professional learning website).

This external version is only to be completed by those who are not employed by the NSW Department of Education and do not have access to the staff portal. Completion of the [internal version](#) for Department of Education staff will also result in NESA accreditation and a MyPL@Edu record.

Both versions of the *Child Protection Awareness Training* contain the same material, which must be completed in the following order.

- Section 1 - Legislation, agencies and policies
- Section 2 - Responsibilities of employees
- Section 3 - Professional practice
